The authors should also detail the natural history commonly encountered in adverse events related to ICI doublet, notably data from RCC, lung and melanoma studies

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This manuscript is a case report about the Immune Checkpoint Inhibitors induced colitis in a patient with malignant melanoma. The importance of this case is the acute occurrence of autoimmune colitis and its improvement after increased dose of prednisone. This article and its figures are educative for clinicians. I recommend some minor typewriting corrections such as Figure 1 and Figure 2 in place of figure 1 and figure 2. Similarly, reference citations should be corrected as (2-4) or (3,7) in place of (2),(3),(4) or (3),(7). Patient temperature should be given as Celsius also for readers outside USA. I think that the table of "Time line of the history" may be shortened using daily basis of events; avoiding same day repeats; there are tree repeats on 08/25/2018, 09/06/2018 and 11/08/2018.
