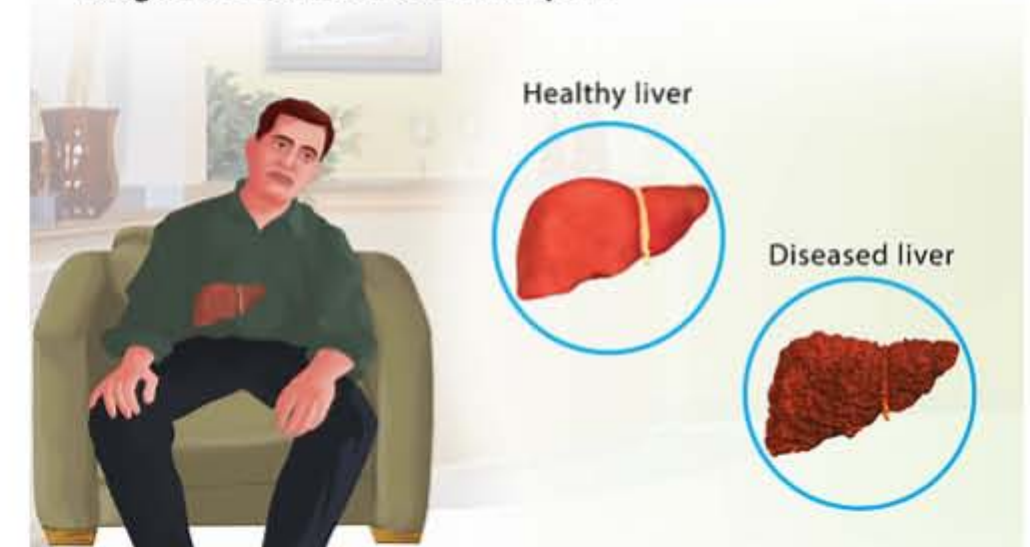
NAFLD contributes as the commonest cause that leads to **cirrhosis**, portal **hypertension** and **hepatic cancer** and it has been estimated that approximately 22% of NAFLD progresses to **cirrhosis**. One of the **study** justified for **performing liver biopsy** for the detection of NAFLD during **cholecystectomy** and that series captured more NAFLD in patients who undergone biopsies than those with simple ultrasound

## Cirrhosis of the Liver

Medical Condition

### Fatigue and severe abdominal pain



A degenerative disease of the liver resulting in scarring and liver failure.

Common (More than 200,000 cases per year in US)

Requires lab test or imaging

Treatments can help manage condition, no known cure

Can last several years or be lifelong

Alcohol abuse and Hepatitis B & C virus infections are the most common causes of cirrhosis. Most common symptoms of cirrhosis are fatigue, weakness, loss of appetite and jaundice. Treatment focuses on delaying or preventing further damage. Medication is prescribed, and surgery is performed in advanced cases.

## Symptoms
