Reviewer #1

Q1: Due to the staging system for RCC has some limitations, the accurate staging is very important for the treatment option.

A1: We agree with Reviewer 1. Accordingly, in the STAGING section of the manuscript we clearly stated that due to the particular and unique characteristics of the transplanted kidney, the modified AJCC staging system represents a better option compared to the standard one. Main differences between standard and modified AJCC staging systems were also reported.

Reviewer #2

Q1: A summary table of the various treatment options, including number of cases, histology, outcome, comments, pros and cons, recommendations, etc. would help the oncology team with the treatment design.

A1: We provided two summary tables (table 1 and table 2) describing main outcomes, advantages, and limitations of current conservative treatment options for localised allograft RCC.
