SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This manuscript is far from being publishable in its current form and needs a huge revision. Please see my comments in the attached copy of the manuscript. All the statements made need appropriate references, and words such as "war" and "fight" should be avoided not to further increase the very stigma that the Authors say should be prevented. The Authors should also considerably expand the possible solutions to the issues mentioned and make "Possible solutions" a separate section.

Re-review comments (2020-02-17 18:39):

The Authors should distinguish the virus (that they should always mention as SARS-CoV-2) from the pneumonia caused by it (COVID-19). I had inserted SARS-CoV-2 in my suggested revision of the original submission but the Authors erroneously reverted back to their terminology.

The English language continues to be imperfect here and there, and needs further revision. Otherwise the manuscript is now acceptable.
