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The manuscript is well researched and well written. However, it does not add much to what we know from the literature since the 80s regarding ABO incompatible liver transplantation. Nonetheless, it still bears interest for the transplant audience because it reports on a case where all the available therapeutic tools have been utilized to prevent an antibody-mediated rejection. Therefore, the case report bears value. I would suggest deleting Figure 1, as it is not necessary, and substituting Figure 2 with a better one. After this minor revision, the paper can be published.
