Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center's (MSK) Cancer Center Support Grant (CCSG) is awarded by the National Cancer Institute (NCI) and provides the major extramural funding for many of the Center's research core facilities. This funding has been integral to MSK's role as an international leader in cancer research and care, and our ongoing status as a CCSG recipient benefits all members of the MSK community.

Therefore, effective September 1, 2015, **all peer-reviewed research publications by MSK faculty or employees** are required to cite the MSK Cancer Center Support Grant/Core Grant (**P30 CA008748**) in the manuscript's funding acknowledgement section, be deposited in PubMed Central (PMC) and assigned a PMCID, and be properly associated with the P30 Core Grant in MyNCBI / My Bibliography.

This Institutional acknowledgment requirement is in addition to any other external funding that may support the project (in part or in whole) and is an expectation regardless of the MSK author's status in the authorship hierarchy.
