- 1- Referring to recent articles, convalescent plasma treatment seems to discontinue COVID-19 shedding, and cannot reduce mortality in critically end-stage COVID-19 patients[1]. It should be given at an early stage, and appears to slow progression of disease and keep people out of the ICU[2]; **added to the discussion section**
- 2- While an open-label nonrandomized control study concluded that Favipiravir showed significantly better treatment effects on COVID-19 in terms of disease progression and viral clearance[3]. Convalescent plasma treatment and Favipiravir were given at the same time period in this case. ; **Considered in the discussion section.**
- 3- My suggestion is to further investigate effects of both treatments and clearly illustrate the therapeutic effects of convalescent plasma and Favipiravir : **added to the recommendations section**
