COVID-19 is now a hot topic. This is a case report of COVID-19 in immunocompromised patients 'post-transplantation. As the author said, at present, how to manage patients with COVID-19 infection is actually a huge challenge. However, for now, COVID-19 affects organs outside the lungs, such as the brain and testes. At present, there are few reports of new coronary pneumonia in patients with LT, and we do not currently know whether COVID-19 will affect LT. The author's case report still needs further follow-up. As far as this case is concerned, it is still necessary to make changes and adjustments in the wrong part. Minor revision: 1. Abstract-Case Summary: LT (LT) should be Liver Transplantation (LT). 2. Abstract-Case Summary and CASE REPORT-History of past illness: Juliet 2019 should be July 2019. I think readers of the Latin Department should understand that Juliet means July. But readers in Western Pacific or Middle Eastern countries do not understand this meaning. 3. CASE REPORT -Imaging examinations: Although the author states that this time the CT scan of the abdomen is of poor quality. However, I think it is necessary to describe the image in words. If there can be a comparison of previous checks, it might be better. 4. DISCUSSION: The content of this part makes the reader feel that it describes two different patients, one is infected with COVID-19 and one with SOT. I think it is necessary to compare SOT-COVID-19 patients with SOT patients alone, from the aspects of medical management, treatment, and prognosis follow-up. The discussion section should be revised. 5. Figure 1 is not clear. Need to change a clear picture, it is best to have more than 300dpi. It is best to have arrows to represent and describe.
