If **surgery** is planned within two weeks then there should be no travel as patients will be asked to self-isolate for 14 days before the operation. A **COVID-19 swab** should be undertaken within 7 days of travel. For travel to proceed this **swab** must be negative for **COVID-19**.

Transplantation is a **high-risk procedure** during this **pandemic** due to the risk of **transmitting COVID-19 infection** from the donor to the recipient as well as risk of recipient developing severe disease under higher levels of immunosuppression in the first 3 months **post-transplant**.
