Abstract

Coronavirus disease-2019 (COVID-19) has so far caused hundreds of mortalities worldwide. Although respiratory symptoms are the main complication in COVID-19 patients, the disease is also associated with gastrointestinal problems - diarrhea, nausea, and vomiting are primary COVID-19 symptoms. Thus cancer, inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) management, stool viral tests, and virus exposure are major concerns in COVID-19 contexts. In colorectal cancer and IBD, colonic mucosa exhibits elevated angiotensin-converting enzyme 2 receptor levels, enhancing COVID-19 susceptibility. In some cases, viral stool positive tests may
