Diabetic retinopathy can worsen during pregnancy and with brisk improvement in glycemic control[3]. In patients with pre-existing diabetes and who have not had their diabetes properly monitored with an evolving imbalance for several years, the establishment of a strict glycemic balance may worsen pre-existing retinopathy and to the extreme, cause retinal bleeding[4].
