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SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

In this manuscript, authors reported a rare case of a 33-year-old postpartum female who presented with sudden onset chest pain and was diagnosed with SCAD and given urgent catheterization. The author also highlighted possible benefits of PCI and CABG for such high-risk patients. Although the overall rationale of the manuscript is interesting, there are some issues that should be addressed to consider this manuscript for publication. 1) The manuscript needs a language and format revision. 2) Please upload a clearer digital version of Figure 1 as well as Figure 2. 3) I don't think the table in "Predisposing factors for spontaneous coronary artery dissection (SCAD)" is appropriate for this paragraph, please update the relevant content. 4) Although the Discussion was well organized, I would like the authors to comment on how it would be applicable in clinic follow-up to reduce the rate of missed diagnosis and to improve the prevention measures especially for the "high-risk" women during the peripartum period.
