Both the first and last author in this invited review have vast experience in biostatistics. Following are the brief write-up of both authors:

First and corresponding author:

Associate Professor Lau Ying focuses her research programme on health promotion among women and their families. Using her methodological expertise in **Systematic Reviews, Meta-Analyses and Meta-Regression**, her specific areas of research focus include achieving psychological well-being among perinatal women. A/Prof Lau has extensive research experience in Singapore, Hong Kong, Macao and Mainland China.

She has secured over SGD\$ 1 million research grants of principal investigator or co-investigator in Singapore and Macao. She has published as first author in high impact journals including Obesity Review, Journal of Medical Internet Research, International Journal of Nursing Studies. The h-index and citations of her papers in Scopus are "18" and "882" respectively on Jul 16, 2020.

Last author:

Mr Cheng Ling Jie is a clinical nurse specialist in the geriatrics medicine ward and also appointed as an executive committee of the nursing research unit at Khoo Teck Puat Hospital. He also served as a **Biostatistics Consultant** at the hospital. Mr Cheng received his Master of Public Health (Majoring in **Biostatistics** and **Epidemiology**) and Bachelor of Science (Nursing) (Honours) from National University of Singapore.

Using his methodological expertise in **Systematic Reviews, Meta-Analyses and Meta-Regression**, Mr Cheng's research focus on health service research, health-related quality of life, prevention of HIV/AIDS and diabetes management. Mr Cheng has experience working in general surgical, medical, and acute stroke unit.
