Gastrointestinal (GI) symptoms are seen in **patients** with COVID-19. The prevalence could be as high as 50%, but most studies show ranges from 16% to 33%. Presenting with **GI symptoms** increases the risk of testing positive for SARs-CoV-2. Approximately 50% of **patients** with COVID-19 have detectable virus in their stool. Having **GI symptoms** has been associated with more severe disease.
