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SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

I read the case report "Cardiac involvement in Hydrocarbon Inhalant toxicity: Role of Cardiac Magnetic Resonance Imaging" by Dr Jolly and colleagues. It is overall acceptable and clinically useful especially for the colleagues who are involved with new generation and of addictive substances. With regards to diagnosis the authors should clarify if NSTEMI was a problem or not. If yes add a sentence to acknowledge it in "final diagnosis". Then I would revise the conclusion and omit words such as myriad. I suggest adding a glossary for abbreviations like MINOCA, UDS, and LGE. Moreover, add units to creatinine and BUN. A polishing will improves writing for instance criteria instead of criterias, etc.
