(1) The key word "Artificial intelligence" is missing in the title and main text. Please discuss and add it;

Response: The title was changed as: " Intrathyroidal Ectopic Thymus: Ultrasonographic Features, Differential Diagnosis, and Artificial Intelligence"

The following paragraph was added in discussion: " Artificial intelligence has been playing an increasing role in the diagnosis of thyroidal disease (13), however as far as we know there is not a study concentrating on the use of artificial intelligence in detecting IET in the English literature. "
