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
Hypocaloric nutrition is defined as nutrition which intentionally delivers less nonprotein nutrients than would be required for daily energy expenditure. Trophic feeding is defined as feeding at a rate under 500 kcal/day. Permissive underfeeding is defined as as feeding under 40-60% of the calories required for daily energy expenditure.


