People with these abnormalities are at higher risk of **cholangiocarcinoma**. Choledochal cysts are bile-filled sacs that are connected to the bile duct. The cells lining the sac often have areas of pre-cancerous growth, which can increase the risk for developing cholangiocarcinoma. It is a rare congenital abnormality.
