Well written, just a few minor observations. You wrote adoelscents in one instance, correct to adolescents. Change personable to personalized. Use inclusive language always (he/she). Use anti-stigma language (patients with depression instead of depressed patients). Be sure that Rona is not the actual name of the girl, to ensure anonymity. State this in the text. Although your intervention is not to be limited to the Covid-19 period, which is successfully dealt with in Israel, there is a worldwide concern about increased suicidal behavior in children and adolescents during the pandemic (Isumi A, Doi S, Yamaoka Y, Takahashi K, Fujiwara T.
