The questions raised by the reviewers should be answered; (3) Format: There are 2 tables and 14 figures; (4) References: A total of 43 references are cited, including 9 references published in the last 3 years; (5) Self-cited references: There are 2 self-cited references. 2 Language evaluation: Classification: Grade A, B and C. A language editing certificate issued by Cambridge Proofreading was provided. 3 Academic norms and rules: The authors provided the Biostatistics Review Certificate, and the PRISMA 2009 Checklist . No academic misconduct was found in the Bing search. 4 Supplementary comments: This is an invited manuscript. No financial support was obtained for the study. The topic has not previously been published in the WJP. 5 Issues raised: (1) We only accept the manuscript in MS Word format, and the manuscript in any other format will be rejected; (2) The authors did not provide original pictures. Please provide the original figure documents.
