Q1. The 4 conditions, patent ductus arteriosus (PDA), mitral valve prolapse (MVP), atrial fibrillation (AF) and hyperthyroidism, do not often occur together, and so the word tetralogy SHOULD NOT be used to describe them.

Answer: The word "tetralogy" has been replaced by the corresponding other words.

Q2. The authors should present details of thyroid function tests (TSH, FT3, FT4), as well as intracardiac chamber pressures on echocardiography so that readers can understand severity of the diseases.

Answer: The details of thyroid function tests are added (chapter of laboratory examinations). The intracardiac chamber pressures on echocardiography are added (chapter of imaging examinations)
