I think there is an issue in this mini-review that the author needs to improve. In this mini-review involving type 1 diabetes, type 2 diabetes and gestational diabetes, as well as a new concept of diabetes, "Type 3 diabetes", in the form of a table, the author should summarize and analyze the bidirectional association between the four types of diabetes and mental disorders, and the possible predisposition factors between them, possible treatment strategies, possible effects on the patient, etc. Through such summary, readers can better understand the relationship between diabetes and mental disorders at a glance, improve the quality of the manuscript, increase the readability of the manuscript, and make it easier to persuade
