Driving Pdx1+ stem cells to become insulin-secreting cells


On behalf of the Directors of the Diabetes Australia Research Trust, I have pleasure in confirming that your application for a Research Grant for 2013 has been successful.

Thank you for your application for funding under the Telethon - Perth Children's Hospital Research Fund 2013 program. The review panel has concluded its assessment of 73 highly competitive applications and I am pleased to advise that an amount of \$199,365 has been awarded to you to undertake the project: Manufacturing mature glucose-responsive insulinsecreting cells for type 1 diabetes therapy.

Please outline any agreed changes to the project proposal that you have made to accommodate the amount offered (where lower than application request) and return the acceptance form no later than Tuesday 17 June 2014, thereby acknowledging that you accept the terms of the grant (as set out in the Telethon - Perth Children's Hospital Research Fund 2013 Application Pack). An electronic 'Acceptance of Offer' form can be obtained upon request.

As per section 2.4 of the Application Pack, all relevant governance approvals, including ethics and institutional approval, must be obtained and copies submitted to the Department of Health's, Research Development Unit (RDU), before commencement of the project. Where applicable, Intellectual Property (IP) agreements must be finalised within 2 months of commencing your project. An IP template is available from the RDU upon request. Should your team include a Department of Health (DoH) employee, please ensure that the RDU has authorised the IP agreement between any non-DoH parties involved in the project.

Payment of grants above \$50,000 will be made in two equal instalments. The first instalment of your grant \$99,682.50, will be transferred to the nominated

administering institution upon receipt of governance approvals and the remaining amount will be transferred after receipt of the Progress Report.

If you require alternative payment arrangements to be made, please contact the RDU at CMOResearchDevelopment@health.wa.gov.au.

I wish to emphasise that by accepting this offer you agree that the project will be completed with a final report and acquittal statement delivered to the RDU by 12 September 2016, and that reporting will include a clear focus on the translation of research findings into health gain for children and adolescents in Western Australia.

A member of the RDU will be assigned to your research project to act as your liaison officer with the Department of Health and to assist with reports and the processing of payments.

As mentioned above, a progress report outlining progress to date is required mid-way through the project. A template and due date for this report will be provided to you at a later date by your liaison officer. Please note that funding may be terminated or withdrawn for a project where insufficient progress has been made.

We request that you await an official media statement by the Minister for Health announcing recipients of this funding before you and/or the administering institution publicise the success of your application. I also ask that you kindly acknowledge the Channel 7 Telethon Trust and the Department of Health as media opportunities arise.
