**Reviewer #1 detailed comments:**

- 1) **The chapter title is not obvious in this review. This may not affect the final publication format, but it caused some trouble to my reading.**
- 2) **In Section of Nanoparticles, magnetic nanoparticles are important candidate that should be discussed.**

**Reviewer #2 detailed comments:**

- 1) **The authors nicely summarized multiple types of drug delivery systems of Curcumin in this manuscript. However, only the text is not easy to understand for the readers. A summary table of different drug delivery systems is helpful to improve this review.**
- 2) **Some repeated contents should be simplified, for example, the full name of VEGF (vascular endothelial growth factor) appeared twice.**
- 3) **The authors should unify the single and plural of the chapter titles, e.g., Polymer, Liposomes, and Microspheres et al.**
