General impression In this study, the authors explored the effects of different anesthesia methods coupled with multi-mode analgesia on postoperative pain in patients with colorectal cancer. And they concluded that general anesthesia coupled with epidural anesthesia and multimode analgesia can achieve better postoperative analgesia and sedation effects, promote postoperative rehabilitation of patients, improve inflammatory stress and immune status, and have higher safety for colorectal cancer patients. I evaluate this clinical report includes so valuable information for the therapy of postoperative pain. Overall, the article is informative and well written, and easy to understand. For these reasons, I think this manuscript is appropriate for publication. However, I have one minor request to be revised as stated below. After they have been resolved, I will judge this manuscript can be accepted and published by this journal. 1. Methods-Control group. Is "multimodal labor pain" a correct phrase? I hope the authors will confirm its rightness. 2. Discussion. I suggested to supplement the limitations of this study and the direction of future research.

Others, The main inadequacies of the article: the innovation of this study is not described in the preface, and the limitations of this study are described less in the final summary. The English expression needs to be further refined. I hope that my comments will be useful in improving the article.
