SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The authors presented a thorough review of the current knowledge on G-POEM which is an emerging area in the field of GI endoscopy. This manuscript summarizes important data that is useful for advanced endoscopists as well as for the basic GI practitioners who are entering the field. This technique is reserved for advanced endoscopist only, and not every Center has applied G-POEM yet, which is the reason for the high interest in this technique. The text is well organized in chapters which makes the article concise. Minor change that should be corrected – in the section 2.2. Submucosal tunneling (page 5), the reference by Stojilkovic et al. was used, but the surname was misspelled.
