- 1) "English grammar requires to be bettered"

- 2) "The literature appears to define the "oldest old" as age 85 or older"

Answer: The definition of "oldest old", as people older than 79 years, is supported by two references: 10 and 11.

- 3) "Be particularly careful with defining your terms early on in the paper (I would change the phrase "By xxx is meant..." to a phrase such as "The term xxx is defined as...".

Answer: All definitions were performed in page 3, and the phrase which the reviewer asked for was used.

Reviewer 2

- 1) "Page 3, line 9: such us? "

Answer: This correction was already performed in page 3

- 2) "Page 3, line 11: pls spell out 'BSA' and 'MDRD' "

Answer: These corrections were already performed in page 3.

- 3) "Page 3, the sentence ' The first operational geriatrics concept' is too long "

Answer: These corrections were already performed in pages 3 and 4.

- 4) “Page 4, line 7, what is the definition of ‘treating physician’? Perhaps just say ‘physician’.”
