(1) The reviewer pointed the following sentence is unclear: The endoclip was extensive use in GI bleeding were found to be inferior to electrocoagulation in stopping bleeding of canine mesenteric arteries of 1 mm and 2 mm in diameter[8]. Now we change this sentence to : The endoclip is effective for active Vascular bleeding, non-bleeding visible vessel and adherent clot [8].
