2 Revision has been made according to the suggestions of the reviewer

- (1) We corrected minor language mistakes;
- (2) We shortened the manuscript by removing part 4 completely. More focus is on the main subject of the manuscript (laparoscopic colorectal surgery) now;
- (3) We emphasized the importance of low index of suspicion and physical exam in detecting anastomotic leakage. We underlined the doubt of the usefulness of cytokines in the absence of clinical signs / physical exam findings in former part 5 (now part 4; detection of anastomotic leakage);
- (4) We rewrote the conclusion as suggested by the reviewer;
- (5) We referred to several papers of Pramateftakis MG, as suggested by one of the reviewers (references 3 and 4).
