(1)For the suggestion of the reviewer 00505544, we explained about each abbreviation at their first mentioned part.

(2)For the suggestion of the reviewer 00503973, we also quite agree. Our present study was a single-center retrospective one and confidence levels were not determined. Further prospective research is required. Then we mentioned in the discussion of manuscript about these limitations and changed assertive descriptions to euphemistic ones: For example, a) "The present data suggest that ....." was changed to "The present data **might** suggest that .....", b) "In conclusion, ..... with the "resect and discard" strategy **can** be avoided" was changed to "In conclusion, ..... with the "resect and discard" strategy **might** be avoided".

(3)For the editor's suggestions, a) We put the reference numbers in square brackets in superscript, b) We added the comments after discussion.
