So we mainly mention about its physiopathology and management rather than renal failure. We think that it is not necessary to give detailed information about KDIGO and AKIN criteria. To provide a broad understanding of the subject physiopathology and definition are kept long. There are several treatment modalities for HRS. Each treatment modality is so broad that a review might be written about. It is not possible to give all the details of each treatment modality we mention only superficially about some of them.
