(3) We removed the last sentence in the conclusion.


(4) We respond about the following questions instead of adding contents.

  - This contents was already described in the discussion. (perforation, bleeding, etc)
- b) The reason that was not performed EUS ?
  - Although we could not performed EUS due to the absence of EUS in our hospital, we think that the use of EUS can render the procedure safer.  
(To confirm that the lesion is confined to the submucosal layer)
  - We think that the ESD without EUS could be performed safely because that the type of colonic lipomas was more like pedunculated type than sessile type in our cases.
