with this I would like to re-submit our manuscript entitled “**Obesity Research: – Status Quo and Future Outlooks.**” (ESPS Manuscript NO: 12886) (edited title) by El Gammal et al. to “*World Journal of Translational Medicine*”.

We believe that our manuscript has been revised thoroughly in response to the reviewers criticisms and suggestions. Moreover, we think that the comments of all reviewers helped us to significantly improve our manuscript.

Reviewer 01482015# stated that our submitted review is comprehensive and was therefore classified as excellent. Further, the manuscript language was evaluated as grade A (priority publishing) and in conclusion our manuscript was graded as “high priority for publication”. However, he has only one minor suggestion.

Reviewer 02440657# commented favourably on our submitted manuscript and stated that our review has an attractive topic, the collected evidence is quite inclusive and the discussion in each section is in great detail. Nevertheless, he has minor suggestions.

1. Minor comment:

Reference 136 is not labelled in the manuscript.

The reference 136 is included in the manuscript. It belongs to table 1. You can find it directly in the legend of table 1.

Response to the remarks of reviewer 02440657#:

1. Minor comment:

As the title emphasized “individualized research”, there is not too much evidence to support the “individualized”. It seems that the content can’t support the title, or the title is not that proper, which need to be reconsidered to make it consistent. As for the writing, there are a lot of grammar errors and confusing sentences which need to be carefully checked.

We now changed the title of our manuscript to ”Obesity research: -Status quo and Future Outlooks.”. We also carefully re-checked the manuscript for errors. All changes are now highlighted in the revised manuscript.

Response to the remarks of reviewer 00043980#:

1. Minor comment:

In the first page of the introduction: 2,1 billion worldwide needs to be changed to 2.1 billion worldwide. In the paragraph regarding the the NKT cells, the last sentence should be “The role of NKTs in obesity still remains unclear”.

Thank you for this comment. We adopted now these suggestions in the revised manuscript.
