1. The length of the «Introduction» section, the «Molecular intracellular mechanisms of GLP-1 activity on the pancreatic  $\beta$ -cell» section and the «Safety of incretin therapies» section have been shortened as suggested. All references were changed accordingly.

2. To the best of my knowledge, currently there are no published data of saxagliptin in prediabetes. However, ongoing clinical trials are investigating its possible role. A comment is made (page 11, 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph, line 6-8) and a reference is added (ref: 68).

(ii) Reviewer 02615858

1. To the best of my knowledge, currently there are no published data of saxagliptin and linagliptin in prediabetes. However, ongoing clinical trials are investigating possible role of saxagliptin and alogliptin. A comment is made (page 11, 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph, line 6-8) and a reference is added (ref: 68) in the section of «Other DPP-4 inhibitors» as suggested.

2. A comment is made (page 21, 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph) and a reference (ref: 137) is added for the cost-effectiveness of incretin-based therapies as suggested.

3. Numerical data from references are checked.

4. The «Safety of incretin therapies» section has been shortened as suggested. All references were changed accordingly.

5. An extensive editing was made.

3. References and typesetting were corrected.
