- We have referred to earlier alternative options for talc pleurodesis such as video-assisted or medical thoracoscopy
- We have added the remark 'in selected cases' to the sentence 'IPC is an alternative method...'
- To our knowledge no literature exists on possible negative influence of IPC on mobility of patients. This is also not our experience.
- We added the reported incidences of spontaneous pleurodesis in IPC treatment in the section on talc pleurodesis vs. IPC (reference numbers 10 and 11)
- To our knowledge no literature is available on the possible relation between type of cancer and degree of symptom control after IPC treatment
