(1) We supplement sufficient histological evidence for diagnosis of mesenchymal hamartoma of liver (**Page 10, paragraph 1**).

(2) We have changed histological photographs in Fig 4 to more clear photographs at high magnification($\times 100$).

(3) According to reviewer's suggestion, we added a table of the literatures which indicate the previous cases at the end of text.

(4) We have changed "a-fetoprotein" to " α -fetoprotein" in **page 8 paragraph 2 line 12**.

(5) In the discussion of paper, we provided profile of mesenchymal hamartoma of adult, and compared characteristics of this disease in adult with infant.

(6) From figure 1, the diagnosis indeed looks like polycystic liver and that's why we initially misdiagnosed this disease as polycystic liver, however, pathological result confirmed the diagnosis of MHL.

(7) According to reviewer's suggestion, we have shortened the description of the operative procedure of the liver Tx (**page 8, paragraph 2**).
