
(reviewer 007365642) (1) The recommendation of the reviewer is good and our first idea was similar, however due to the heterogeneity of the reported complications in the manuscripts, it is quite difficult to describe exactly the total number of patients studied nor the total number of manuscripts selected because sometimes intra and postoperative complications are written mixed in the same manuscript and resulted hard to split. To try to adjust the material and methods to the recommendations we have made changes in this section and I hope they glad you. (2) We decided not to include retroperitoneal node dissection because in our daily practice this procedure does not suppose an important volume. Reviewing the EAU guidelines in only specifically recommended for testis cancer and in comparison with kidney, upper tract and adrenal oncology, is much more infrequent. We appreciate the recommendation but we prefer not to include it. (3) We have made changes in this sense and we have re-written some part recommended.
