
2 Revision has been made according to the suggestions of the reviewer

- (3) The margin of EMR is clean, based on endoscopic and pathologic view.
- (4) The patient refused further surgical treatment, therefore the follow up was made for this patient, of course the decision was also based on the CT scan and pathologic result.
- (5) The follow-up was made at the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> month after EMR, which mainly included the esophagogastroduodenoscopy and the color Doppler ultrasound.
- (6) Of course, it is too early to draw any conclusion about the correct treatment. So we change our word to be 'might be'. The EMR method might be an option for duodenal adenocarcinoma with neuroendocrine features.
