2 We have modified the manuscript according to Reviewers' suggestions:

- Reviewer 00000194 - The reviewer is asking about a possible relationship with IgG4 disease. As far as we know, no association between IgG4 disease and celiac disease has been reported.

As suggested by this reviewer, we have discussed in more detail the possible pathogenetic mechanisms of liver damage in celiac disease, and have including a figure illustrating this topic.
