Page 14-about neuroendocrine tumor-when the diameter exceeds 500 um they become endoscopically detectable-it contradicts the previous phrase: not detectable at endoscopy with 0,5-5 mm.

Page 15-line 10. Low proliferative. Not lowproliferative. Page 25 reference 1-should not have a point at the end of the sentence.
