- (2) Histopathology characteristics have been mentioned; patient did not undergo laparoscopic or open excision hence gross specimen not available (patient passed hydatid cyst remnants in urine and collected in container - photograph included in the article)
- (3) Percentage of each type of Gharbi cyst as per sonography has been included and the table and its reference have been updated. However, no specific article quoting percentage prevalence of various sonographic variants in India could be found.
- (4) Reference has been made to two previous reports similar to our submission and reference section updated appropriately. Differences and the uniqueness of our case have been highlighted.
- (5) Magnification in microscopy has been mentioned as requested and legend for figure 5 has been updated accordingly.
