

## Answers to the **Reviewers**:

### **Reviewer 1:**

1) It might be ideal if the authors state the aims of the study. They have a good introduction and a brief paragraph regarding the literature search methods but missed the goal of the study.

-In the end of the introduction: " This article aims at reviewing, based on the existing literature, the psychosocial aspects related to the selection, monitoring and follow-up of ALD patients subject to liver transplantation".

2) In pages 4 and 5 the authors use the LTX abbreviation that, in the context of the paper seems to be "liver transplant or liver transplantation" but they never defined it. They will have to clarify this issue in the first appearance of the abbreviation in page 4, second paragraph, line 10.

3) In page 6, second paragraph, line 11 says "... and it might be an useful instrument..." and it should read "... and it might be a useful instrument..."

4) In page 6, third paragraph, line 28 says "...the author advises that the patient improves their state..." and it should say "... the author advises that the patients improve their state..." as the original sentence combines singular and plural subjects.

5) In page 9, third paragraph, lines 20 and 21; the text reads "These effects are named "antiabuse" or "disulfiram-like". The authors should clarify that the correct spelling in English is Disulfiram for the generic substance and Antabuse (not antiabuse) is the trade mark for the pharmaceutical company manufacturing the drug.

6) In page 10, first paragraph, line 1 it says "... (especially miu receptor)..." The authors should change "miu" for the conventional ? Greek character.

7) In page 10, first paragraph, line 7 the authors use the term transaminases. I suggest using the current term aminotransferases.

8) In page 10, fourth paragraph, line 18 the authors use the abbreviation RCT; in the context of the paper seems that the abbreviation means randomized control trial but this needs to be clarified as the abbreviation was not used before.

9) The table #1 uses all upper case letters; I suggest using upper and lower case characters and clarify some abbreviations: a. > 6M meaning > 6 months? b. PERS. DIS. Meaning personality disorder? c. NR OF YEARS meaning number of years?
