

**Plecanatide and dolcanatide, novel guanylate cyclase-C agonists, ameliorate gastrointestinal inflammation in experimental models of murine colitis**

**Biostatistics:** Animal studies were conducted by the Epistem Co., UK. Each cohort in the study contained n=8-10. Hence, statistical analysis by a profession was not essential. Therefore, statistical significance was performed by the authors. As stated under Materials and Methods this involved comparing mean values of the control with that of the drug-treated samples, using 2-way unpaired Student T-tests, assuming unequal variance, in Microsoft Excel and PRISM softwares. A p value <0.05 was considered to be statistically significant.



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
