### **Reviewer 1**

" ..... Another aspect we encountered in practice is the defunctioning stoma. Its indications,time to reversion and stenosis of anasomatic stricture caused by radiation are all related problems in terms of quality of life. Also, perineal wound complications such as abscess,dishescence and chronic pain after surgery accounts in the quanlity of life."

**RE:** Both the theme of temporary loop ileostomies and perineal wound complications have now been addressed in the manuscript.

"There are a few issues that have not been adequately covered in this manuscript: 1. the issue of extended pelvic lymph nodes dissection and its impact in genitourinary function 2. the issue of transanal TME 3. the issue of robotic TME 4. the recently established scoring system dedicated for assessment of anterior resection syndrome"
