First of all we thank the reviewer for the precious comments. We changed some paragraphs of the manuscript according to the comments. In particular we added a thorough chapter about the association between HCV and psoriasis (see the underlined sections). Moreover, the clinical studies cited by the reviewer has been included in the main body of the manuscript among other papers that deal with psoriasis and HCV therapy.

We still believe that this review may enrich the body of knowledge of all the clinicians dealing with patients undergoing antiviral treatment for HCV infection.
