Within the revised manuscript were no requests for any specific changes.

As required, we added the conflict-of-interest statement handwritten signed (file number 5), although we already provided it within the first submission.

The figures were composed in a professional graphic software (Corel Designer) and cannot be directly exported into powerpoint. We think that our illustrations are well readable, logically composed and do not require further editing. Redesign of all figures in a software such as powerpoint (which is not a software suitable for production high-quality illustrations) would require much additional work and does not improve anything.

Therefore, we would highly appreciate if you

- 1) either could tell us, which of the below mentioned file formats (supported by Corel Designer) would be acceptable
- 2) or tell us, which specific changes we should implement in our figures
- 3) or use the Figures as provided in the original format.

Above mentioned files 7, 8, 9 and 10 contain different file formats for each figure which may be used for your further editing.

The manuscript has been carefully revised for English language - we believe that the language of our manuscript has reached Grade A and therefore chose not to make use of additional language editing services. As our institution does not have institutional access to ‘Crosscheck’, no systematic plagiarism detection has been performed – see enclosed for ‘Google Scholar’-based assessment of the manuscript title.

We hope that the manuscript is now suitable for publication.
