1. For ultrasonig and biyopsy findings of the patient, we do not have any other positive finding other than the "hepatosteatosi and cholestasi "and "Moderate cholestatic injury accompanying chronic hepatitis, and degenerative and dysplastic changes in bile ducts" which were stated in the text.
2. The antiviral therapy is named in parenthesis at the end of the case report presentation.
3. Cryoglobulinemic vasculitis is decided to be present with the dermatological findings, and a sentence indicating this subject is added to the text (to the discussion).
