We believe that, despite interesting, these additional figures and the corresponding amount of additional space could be redundant. Moreover, to provide an equal and fully comprehensive overview of all the available devices and instrumentations provided by different companies, we should display several images, which have been already published, thereby adding only a diminutive additional value to the present manuscript. Nonetheless, whenever the Reviewer or the Editor would definitively support the presence of images, we will be glad to provide them quickly.

**- Reviewer #3:** *"1.Abstract section: The aauthors should not use abbro. such as IBD in this section. 2. Key words: colorectal canser can be omit. 3. Molecular imaging section could be omit. 4. The authors can add a sharp conclusion paragh will be better"*

**Author's reply:** Thank You for these valuable comments. Accordingly,

- 1) We have replaced the abbreviation "IBD" from the abstract section;
- 2) We have deleted the key word "colorectal cancer";
- 3) We have shortened the paragraph on molecular imaging; however since molecular imaging is a rapidly evolving field that has gained increased attention in the recent past, we suggest to leave a short and relevant part of this paragraph in the manuscript. Further, we have added a short conclusion paragraph to the revised manuscript.
