-Suggest to give a detailed description of treatment including steroid dosage, duration: Done. Highlighted.

-Suggest to combine figure 2 and figure 3 into one figure. Then describe two pictures separately in picture A and B. Figures 2 and 3 can be combined by your editors into a single picture labeled "Figure 2". I would not advise calling it "picture A and B", as publications do not refer to pictures as pictures, but rather as "figures".

- It will be good if the author can provide pictures of the physical examination: I do not believe this will change the overall message, educational aspects, content, and discussion points of this case report.

-Grammar correction: in Abstract: second paragraph, last sentence. Done (highlighted)

REVIEWER 3:

-Concerns: 1. In Figs, indicators can be used to introduce the interesting areas. In addition, no scale bars are indicated in any photographic data. U/S's images don't typically include scale bars. Furthermore, practitioners that look at U/S's would easily recognize the abnormality on this ultrasound, and a marker would simply oversaturate the image unnecessarily.

- Several grammar mistakes exist, and should be corrected. For example, "The was started on steroid therapy to which she responded well." Done, highlighted

-*"The exact etiology remains unkown."* . Not sure where the grammatical error is?
