- i. Thank you for your valuable review Peripheral cemento-ossifying fibroma though accounts for 3.1% of all oral tumors. But very few cases have been reported in the age group mentioned by the author which is a rare finding References have been organised & formatted according to the journals requirements , formatting in terms of consistency language use, figures or pictures have been cut down
- ii. It may occur at any range, but exhibits a peak incidence between the second and third decade<sup>1,2</sup>. However Neville et al <sup>3</sup> say that it predominantly affects adolescents and young adults, with a peak prevalence between 10 and 19 years. Also the author himself in a previous study reports a peak prevalence of 28 yrs<sup>4</sup> .
